- Be a positive role model
 - Develop a coaching philosophy and share with the club
 - Coach within the rules and respect official and their decisions
 - Respect your opponents
 - Obtain appropriate qualifications
 - Experience different levels of netball as much as possible
 - Improve your own technical knowledge at every opportunity
 - Develop individual player skill at every opportunity
 - Work with other coaches and help develop potential coaches as the opportunities arise
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- Plan training sessions with a specific goal(s) in mind
 - Encourage players to contribute to sessions
 - Be willing to adapt training sessions
 - Appreciate that players learn at different speeds
 - Maintain an appropriate balance between the needs of the player and the desire to win
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- Support club officials and players where ever possible
 - Keep to agreed timings for training/competitions, inform a club officials/players if going to be late
 - Inform club officials/players if unable to attend training as soon as you know
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- Treat every player equitably, regardless of age, ability, gender, race, religion, ethnic origin, social status or sexual orientation
 - Report any concerns you may have in relation to a young person, following the reporting procedures laid down by England Netball
 - Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of all players
 - Be aware of and abide by England Netball's safeguarding and protecting young people policy, procedures and guidelines
