- Meet at least 30 minutes before games
- Inform your captain if unable to attend training as soon as you know

- Refrain from smoking, drinking or drug use whilst representing the club at competitions
- Before registering with/ playing for another club discuss with Club Captain

- Always give 100% effort at training and games
